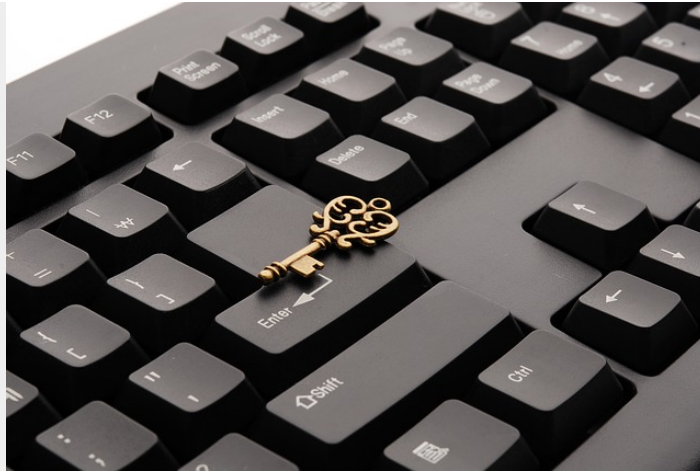


CAN I MAKE MONEY ONLINE?

An offline business would typically be in debt the first year, break even the second and start making profits on the third. (And that's a successful business) Most fail by default, (they give up).

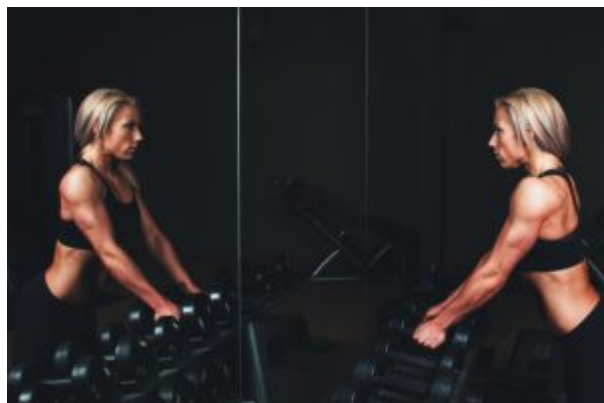
